The GWU Elliott School of International Affairs will provide Clarke DS Fellows enrolling in its eligible master's programs a merit-based scholarship of a least \$18,000 for tuition amounts not covered by the Clarke DS Fellowship tuition assistance.

The scholarship is awarded for the first year of study and is renewable in the second year provided the student remains a Clarke DS Fellow in good academic standing, maintaining above a 3.2 GPA in their first year.

## Eligible Programs

Clarke DS Fellows are eligible to enroll in the following four-semester, full-time master's degree programs offered by the GWU Elliott School:

- · M.A. Middle East Studies
- M.A. Security Policy Studies (On-Campus or Online)

- M.A. in International Development Studies
- · M.A. in International Science and Technology Policy

## **Application for Admission**

The GWU Elliott School will waive its application fee for all students who apply to the Clarke DS Fellowship program. Applicants to GWU Elliott School should indicate on their application and resumé that they are applying for the Clarke DS Fellowship.

Clarke DS Fellowship finalists not selected for the Fellowship will be given equal consideration for merit-based awards from the school after the published admissions deadline date. All Clarke DS Fellowship finalists will be considered for other merit-based awards offered by the GWU Elliott School. No separate application is required.
