Scholarship for Clarke DS Fellows

The Fletcher School will award scholarships to enrolled Clarke DS Fellows. These scholarships will cover the difference between the school's full-time tuition and the Clarke DS Fellowship tuition assistance. The award will be made at the time of admission (no separate application is necessary). To be considered, applicants should indicate their status as a Clarke DS Fellow in the fee waiver section of the Fletcher Scholarship Application Form.

The scholarship is awarded for the first year of study and is renewable in the second year provided the student remains a Clarke DS Fellow in good academic standing.

Eligible Programs

Clarke DS Fellows are eligible to enroll in the following four-semester (fall and spring), full-time master's programs offered by The Fletcher School:

- Master of Arts in Law and Diplomacy (MALD)
- Master of International Business (MIB)

Additional Benefits for Clarke DS Fellows

- The Fletcher School will waive the application fee for Clarke DS Fellows.
- Clarke DS Fellows may be eligible for a stipend of up to \$300 by the Fletcher School to defray travel costs for Fletcher's visitation events. Prospective students are invited to visitation events to see the school and to meet faculty, staff, and current students.
- The Fletcher School will waive the \$500 deposit fee and health services fee for enrolled Clarke DS Fellows.
- Candidates of the Clarke DS Fellowship who are not selected for the fellowship will be given equal consideration, like any other Fletcher applicant, for merit-based awards.

Admission Requirements at The Fletcher School

To apply, prospective students must submit the following materials:

- Online application form
- Official academic transcripts from all previously attended institutions.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation
- Two (2) essays
- Optional test score reports: GRE or GMAT
- Resume
