



University of New Orleans – Computer Science Department Partnership Agreement



As a Supporting Partner, the University of New Orleans-Computer Science Department identifies two master's degree programs for which FAIT Fellows are eligible. All FAIT Fellowship finalists will be considered for other merit-based awards with no separate application required.

FAIT Fellows: Graduate Fellowship Candidates

As a Supporting Partner, the University of New Orleans-Computer Science Department (UNO-CS) encourages FAIT Fellowship graduate candidates to apply for admission to an eligible master's degree program. Tuition assistance provided by the FAIT Fellowship covers the entire tuition amount at UNO. All FAIT Fellowship finalists will be considered for other merit-based awards with no separate application required.

Eligible Programs

The UNO-CS supporting partnership program is designed for FAIT Fellows who have a bachelor's degree in computer science or related discipline. Those who have limited computer science background are eligible to apply after completing the foundational prerequisites that will help them succeed in their graduate coursework.

FAIT Fellows are eligible to enroll in these four-semester master's programs offered by UNO-CS:

- MS in Computer Science
- MS in Cyber Security and Operations

Application for Admission

UNO will waive its application fee for all students who are applying for the FAIT Fellowship program. Applicants to UNO should indicate on their application and resume that they are FAIT Fellowship candidates or a selected Fellow.
