SHSU Eligible Graduate Degree Programs

FAIT Fellows in the graduate fellowship program are eligible to enroll in the following four-semester (fall and spring), full-time master's degree programs offered by SHSU:

- · Master of Science in Computing and Data Science
- · Master of Science in Digital Forensics*
- · Master of Science in Information Assurance & Cybersecurity*

SHSU Eligible Undergraduate Degree Programs

The following bachelor's degree programs are eligible for the undergraduate FAIT Fellowship program. Students must be enrolled full-time and be on a timeline to graduate after completing four full-time semesters (fall and spring) during their two-year fellowship.

- · Bachelor of Science in Computing Science
- Bachelor of Science in Software Engineering
- · Bachelor of Science in Cybersecurity

Applying to SHSU

To apply to SHSU with a waived application fee:

- · Create an account on Apply Texas (goapplytexas.org)
- · Login to your SHSU Self Serve Center
- · Submit the following materials:
 - Online application
 - Graduate program applicants: Official transcript of the baccalaureate degree-granting institution showing the date of the degree conferral.
 - Other program-specific admission materials. Some programs require additional information such as letters of recommendation, essays, and documentation of experience.
 - Copy the email confirmation for your FAIT Fellowship application submission from The Washington Center.
